



The national challenge

Healthcare systems are facing rising demand from members with chronic and advanced conditions. These individuals often experience fragmented care and higher utilization due to unmet medical, emotional, and social needs. Effective support must address the whole person across time, not just at crisis points.

Carelon closes gaps by identifying, engaging, and managing high-risk members at scale.



12M adults live with serious illness in the U.S. Only **14%** receive care.⁵

Unmanaged symptoms lead to avoidable hospitalizations and a higher spend.



The top **5%** of healthcare spenders account for **50%** of total healthcare expenditures. People needing palliative care are among this group.⁵

If palliative care fully penetrated the nation's hospitals, total savings could exceed **\$6 billion** per year.⁵



Compassionate solutions that start sooner

Palliative care is often associated with end-of-life services, but it's actually appropriate much earlier in the course of serious illness. Members facing conditions like cancer, heart failure, COPD, and neurologic diseases can benefit from extra support well before they are near the end of life. It can begin as soon as someone is diagnosed, even while they continue treatment.

With the right care plan, palliative care can reduce stress, prevent costly crises, and align treatment with the patient's goals.

It's not about giving up. It's about improving comfort, care coordination, and quality of life.

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

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
